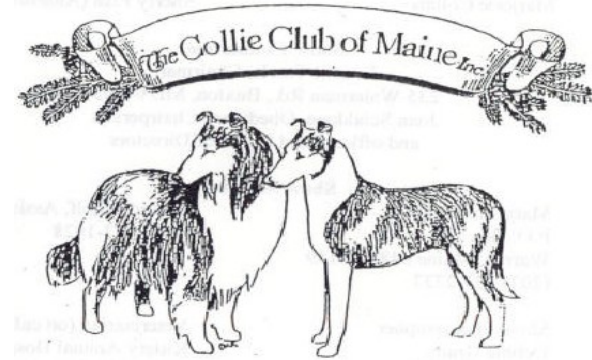

Open to all collie puppies Rough or Smooth, 6 months of age or older, but under 18 months on the day of the Specialty. All puppies entered for Sweepstakes MUST be entered in one of the regular classes at the show. To enter, indicate SWEEPSTAKES in space provided for ADDITIONAL CLASSES on the entry form. Best Puppy in Sweepstakes will receive 60% and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes will receive 40% of the total sweepstakes entry fees. The sweepstakes will be divided into Dogs and Bitches; also into 6-9, 9-12, and 12-18 months.

Veteran Sweepstakes will be open to all collies who are 7 years and over on the day of the show.

Indicate Vet. Sweep. and age division on regular entry form under additional classes.

Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged following Puppy Sweepstakes. Best Veteran will receive 60% and Best Opposite sex will receive 40% of the entry fee. Sweepstakes will be divided into Dogs and Bitches also into 7 years and under 9 years and 9 years and over.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
